### Merced Superior Court Modifies Operations

On March 17, 2020, the Merced Superior Court (Court) announced its plan to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19, which included a number of court operational changes. On March 21, 2020 the Court announced further operational changes. Court administration has been carefully monitoring the advice of public, state and federal health officials regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. Due to the ongoing risks presented by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Court is modifying its operations.

The goal of the Merced Superior Court during this unprecedented situation is to protect the safety, health and welfare of court customers, jurors and staff. To this end, we request that individuals refrain from visiting the Court whenever possible. Effective Wednesday, December 9, 2020, Clerk's Offices will be closed to the public, except for essential filings limited to, restraining orders, protective orders, emergency petitions and emergency ex-parte requests. Please see the clerk's office closure notice on our website [www.mercedcourt.org](http://www.mercedcourt.org) for detailed hours and drop box locations.

Telephones will be answered from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and drop boxes will be processed throughout the day. Merced Traffic will answer telephones from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

**Court operations will continue with remote appearances strongly encouraged. Entry to court facilities are subject to screening requirements.**

1. Only parties and attorneys required to appear in a court hearing will be permitted to enter the court facilities on the day of the hearing after submitting to screening and absent any signs of illness. Witnesses must appear by remote appearance unless otherwise ordered by the judicial officer. Do not bring friends or family members with you as they will not be permitted inside the buildings.
2. Limited seating is available for in-person observations of criminal jury trials. Additional limited accommodations are available for remote trial observations.
3. All persons entering the court facilities shall wear a face covering or face mask while in any Merced Court facility unless otherwise ordered by a judicial officer.

4. All persons entering a Merced Court facility shall submit to a non-invasive temperature screening process and/or declaration and SHALL NOT enter if a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher is detected. Those not permitted to enter the court facilities should contact their attorney or the clerk's office if not represented by an attorney.
5. Do not come to the court if you are ill and experiencing flu-like symptoms or have a fever or cough. Do not come to the court if you have a scheduled appointment for COVID testing, have tested positive or likely have COVID-19. Do not come to the court if you've been exposed to someone who has tested positive or are in quarantine. If you are represented by an attorney, please contact your attorney prior to coming to court to determine whether you need to appear in person. In most instances, your attorney can appear for you. If you do not have an attorney, you may contact the Clerk's Offices listed below. Telephones will be answered Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The traffic office will answer telephones Monday-Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

6. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged, and may be required in some courtrooms, to prevent exposure to and the spread of COVID-19. ## **Operations Update**

### **Civil Operations (including Juvenile Dependency) – (209) 725-4111**

- Clerk's Office hours: 8:00 am – 3:00 pm (Essential filings only)
- Courtroom 8 combined with Courtroom 10 (Unlimited Civil, Juvenile Dependency and Probate) will continue with hearings as scheduled in Courtroom 10. Remote proceedings only, no in-person appearances.
- Courtroom 9 - Limited Civil and Small Claims hearings will continue as scheduled. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged and in-person access is limited to allow for social distancing.

### **Criminal Operations – (209) 725-4113**

- Clerk's Office hours: 8:00 am – 3:00 pm (Essential filings only)
- Courtrooms 1, 2, 3 and 6 –Felony/Specialty Criminal calendars will continue as scheduled. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged with limited in-person appearances allowed.

- Courtrooms 4 and 5 – Misdemeanor calendars will continue as scheduled. PC 977 and remote appearances are strongly encouraged with limited in-person appearances allowed.

**Family Law Operations – (209) 725-4117**

- Clerk’s Office hours: 8:00 am – 3:00 pm (Essential filings only)
- Courtroom 7 – Family Law calendars will be heard telephonically as scheduled. No in person appearances are permitted. Any parties appearing at the courthouse will be asked to provide their telephone numbers and contacted by telephone for their hearing for cases. - Courtroom 4 – DCSS and DV calendars will continue to be heard as scheduled. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged with limited in-person access limited to allow for social distancing.
- Family Court Services - Child Custody Recommending Counseling will remain remote.

**Juvenile Delinquency Operations – (209) 725-4119**

- Courtroom 11 – Juvenile Delinquency calendars remain as scheduled at Juvenile Hall. Remote appearances only.

2. Courtroom 5 will continue to hear its normal calendars. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged with in-person access limited to allow for social distancing.

**Courtroom 6:**

1. Courtroom seating is limited to allow for social distancing.
2. Courtroom 6 will continue to hear its normal felony calendars. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged with in-person access limited to allow for social distancing.

**Courtroom 7:**

1. Courtroom 7 will continue to hear its normal Family Law calendars. No in-person appearances are permitted. Any parties appearing at the courthouse will be asked to provide their telephone numbers and contacted by telephone for their hearing for cases. **Courtroom 8:**

1. Courtroom 8 will continue to be combined with Courtroom 10. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged with in-person access limited to allow for social distancing.

**Courtroom 9:**

1. Contact the Traffic Division to schedule your hearings, including walk-in arraignments. Provide the clerk's office with your phone number for remote appearances.
2. Courtroom seating is limited to allow for social distancing.
3. Courtroom 9 will continue its normal Traffic, Small Claims and Limited Civil matters. Remote appearances are strongly encouraged with in-person access limited to allow for social distancing.

**Courtroom 10:**

1. Courtroom 10 will continue with all hearings heard remotely. No parties will be permitted in the courtroom itself.
2. Courtroom 8 calendars will continue to be heard in Courtroom 10.

**Courtroom 11:**

1. Courtroom 11 Juvenile Delinquency calendars remain as scheduled at Juvenile Hall. Privacy requirements dictate that only individuals involved in a given case may be present when that case is proceeding. Remote appearances only.

**1159 "G" Street, Los Banos, CA Courthouse:**

**Courtroom 12:**

1. Courtroom 12 will continue with remote hearings only, although a limited number of individuals who appear at the courthouse may be permitted to use the courthouse terminals to participate in the remote hearings. Nobody will be allowed in the courtroom itself.

**Courtroom 13:**

1. Courtroom 13 will continue its Family Law matters and will allow remote hearings only, although a limited number of individuals who appear at the courthouse may be permitted to use the courthouse terminals to participate in the remote hearings. Nobody will be allowed in the courtroom itself.

**Jury Service – (209) 725-4121**

- Hours of operation: 8:00 am to 5:00 pm

Jury service will continue. Be assured that we are working with the County Health Department to ensure your safety. The court has installed hand sanitizing stations throughout the facilities

and will be observing social distancing for juror deliberations. Additional precautionary measures include temperature scanning, temporary offsite large venues to allow for increased social distancing, batching smaller reporting groups and staggering the reporting times to allow for entry screening.
